

Privacy Policy

This website is operated by Manhattan Beach Brewing Company, LLC doing business as BREWCO Manhattan Beach ("BREWCO"). Data privacy is important to BREWCO. We do not actively collect any personal data from you on our website or through social media ("Digital Platforms"). As we continue to develop our Digital Platforms and take advantage of technologies to improve the services we offer, this policy may change. We therefore encourage you to refer to this policy on an ongoing basis so that you understand our current privacy policy. This policy was last updated June 1, 2018. By using our Digital Platforms you signify your acceptance of our Privacy Policy as written. If you do not agree to this policy please do not use our Digital Platforms. We have structured our Digital Platforms so that you can visit us on the website or through third-party social media sites without identifying yourself or revealing any personal data to us.
